

Intensive Winter Course IPA/Structural Funds

19-23 March 2012, Brussels

The ECORYS Academy has designed this intensive winter course based on our experience with the 'regular' MTEC IPA/Structural Funds training that we have been providing since 2001. This course is designed for government officials from New EU Member States involved in Structural Funds and those from Candidate States involved in the management of IPA/Structural Funds.

What will you get of this course?

A combination of seven modules, each with practical sessions and exercises, creating a comfortable and interactive working atmosphere. The modules are:

- Module 1: EU Structural Funds/IPA: concepts and context. This module familiarizes participants with the basic concepts of the IPA and Structural Funds;
- Module 2: Strategic Planning and Programming. Participants will get acquainted with programming and will be able to apply programming techniques and tools (SWOT and logical framework analysis);
- Module 3: Implementation and Absorption Capacity. Participants will get familiarized with project pipeline development, project development and indicators, programme and project implementation and project appraisal and feasibility. This module facilitates practical understanding of effective strategies to communicate and promote the policies and priorities of programmes and projects;
- Module 4: Financial Management, Control and Rules. The main objective of this module is to get acquainted with financial management and control;
- Module 5: Monitoring and Evaluation. This module provides participants with knowledge of the concept and use of monitoring data, data collection and management. Participants will understand the main requirements for the evaluation of Structural Funds programmes and IPA components;
- Module 6: Negotiations. With this module the participants will get insights and skills in negotiating with(in) the EU;
- Module 7: assignment EC-funded project proposal preparation and project cycle management. This module trains participants in preparing EC-funded project proposals, including feasibility studies, impact assessment and risk analysis.



Who is this course designed for?

The winter course is designed for government officials from regional and central governments of the New Member States and (potential) Candidate countries such as Croatia, Serbia, Macedonia, Montenegro, Turkey, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Kosovo and Albania. Employees from any organization involved in the management of IPA/Structural Funds are potential participants. This course has been developed on the request of those potential participants who applied for the 'regular' MTEC IPA/Structural Funds training, but could not participate so far because of the immense interest.

Background and learning effects Winter Course

Over the last decade, ECORYS has run its EU funds training programme in almost all new Member States and Accession countries. On the basis of our longstanding experience, we know that creating capacity is equally essential for both the pre-accession and the post-accession period.
